Eureka 54 Junior's Report Card Policy

The intent of the report card policy is to insure that Eureka Volunteer Fire & Ambulance Company will not be responsible for junior and senior high school students failing in their academic studies. This policy applies to all students in school. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

- 1. It is the junior responsibility to submit their report card to the junior advisor within 48 hours after being issued.
- 2. If the advisor does not see a report card within 2 weeks, an immediate suspension will take place. (unless special situation warrant delay)
- 3. After submitting the report card to the junior advisor the following procedures will take place:

A: For each and any failing grades, an automatic 14 day suspension will take place.

B: Following the appropriate suspension the parents or guardian is to contact the advisor as to whether the grades have improved.

C: Upon improving grades the suspension may be revoked, however if the student is still failing the suspension will continue until acceptable grades are attained.

- 4. Any member that is in school must be off station grounds by 8:30 pm (20:30) on school nights, unless involved with training.
- 5. These rules are subject to change with the Eureka VFC approval.
